

# STUDENTS BOARD SPECIFIC GUIDANCE SESSIONS



The Wizards of Coding Competition by 'THE EDUCATORS' aims to prepare young learners for the digital future by building technological literacy through early exposure to coding. It introduces coding as a new type of literacy for Grade 2 students, offering a fun and interactive way to explore basic coding concepts. Using the Scratch 3 Desktop App, a visual programming language designed for early learners, students develop logical thinking and creativity, giving them a strong start in understanding how technology works and laying the foundation for their future.

**Version 1.1 of Quizillapro**, launched by 'THE EDUCATORS' & Beaconhouse, now supports Punjab, Sindh, KPK and Federal Boards. Since its rollout, the platform has enabled the generation of over **4500 curriculum-aligned** question papers, streamlining assessment for teachers nationwide.

**Now introducing Version 1.2** - a dedicated Quiz App for Secondary Students, with over 10,000 students registered. The MCQ-based app includes:

- \* Practice Mode - unlimited self-paced quizzes
- \* Competition Mode - single-attempt quizzes at basic, intermediate and advanced levels

Students scoring 80% and above will receive e-certificates based on overall subject performance at the end of the academic session.



## MOU SIGNING CEREMONY WITH PAKISTAN YOUTH FORUM WELFARE TRUST (PYF)

'THE EDUCATORS' signed an MOU with Pakistan Youth Forum Welfare Trust (PYF) to support Aghaaz School faculty and improve education for underprivileged students.
